[D] Misty taste of moonshine [C] tear drop in my [G] eye

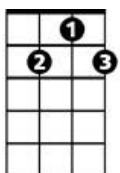

And when I [G] looked the moon had [D] turned to [G] gold [Gaug]

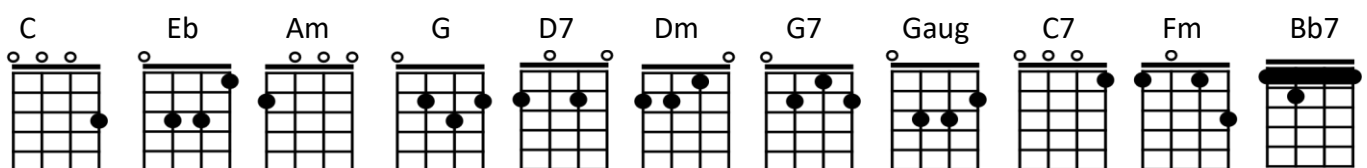
