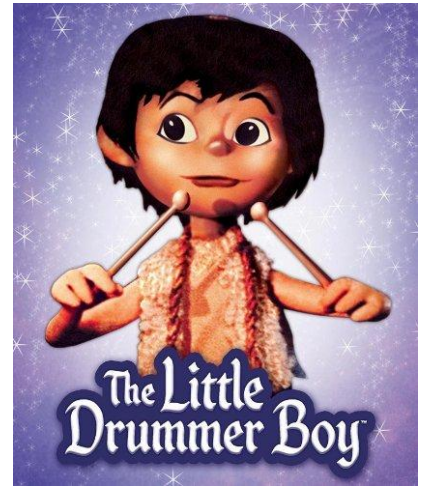


Little Drummer Boy

[C]Little Mary's feeling ercky, [F]fa la la la [C]la, la la [G7]la [C]la.

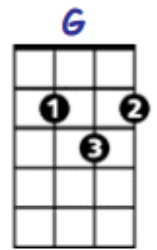

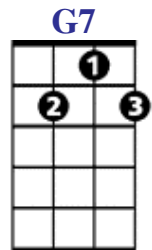


Silent Night

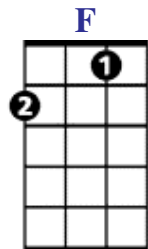
